## **Elements of Time-Based Coding**

Provider time includes the following activities, when performed:

- Preparing to see the patient such as reviewing the pts record
- Obtaining and/or reviewing separately obtained history
- Performing a medically appropriate history and examination
- Counseling and educating the patient, family, and/or caregiver
- Ordering prescription medications, tests, or procedures
- Referring and communicating with other health care providers when not separately reported during the visit
- Documenting clinical information in the EHR
- Independently interpreting results when not separately reported
- Communicating results to the patient/family/caregiver
- Coordinating the care of the patient when not separately reported

+99417 – Prolonged office or other outpatient evaluation and management service(s), each 15 minutes of total time Example: A visit of 84 minutes with an established patient would be 99215 plus two 99417 prolonged service

\*New Pts: If total time is less than 15 minutes, No Code will apply. If time is greater than 74 add Prolonged EM Service.
\*Est Pts: If total time is less than 10 minutes, No Code will apply. If times greater than 55 minutes add Prolonged EM Service. Total time must fall exactly into the ranges for the code to apply.
